Official Practice Ice Procedure:

A Team may enter the ice surface for their practice session once their name is announced and the preceding team has been asked to exit the ice.

The Team must exit the ice immediately when their practice segment is over.

Competition:

ISU Rule 964

- a) Short Program and Free Skating, each Team shall be allowed a warm-up of at least one (1) minute in duration (without their music during the judging time of the previous Team) before the Team is called to start.
- b) A Team must not take more than thirty (30) seconds for exiting the ice surface for both the Short Program and Free Skating.
- c) The first Team of each starting group is granted **a two (2) minute** warm up period before their call to start.

The Referee's Assistant Ice permits the first and each additional Team to enter the ice for their warm-up.
