6) Selection process	<p style="text-align: center;">Apart from the skaters automatically nominated (see line item 3), the following criteria apply for the remaining slots/substitute slots provided the athletes are likely to fulfill the goals set forth by Swiss Ice Skating as indicated above:</p> <p>1) Taking into account (in competitions covered under line item 5): the two highest Senior Combined Total Element Score + - the validation of a 3A or a quadruple jump (GOE-1 minimum) for Men, - the qualification for the free program at the European Championships 2025 for Pairs, must have been achieved;</p> <p>2) The final placement in the European Championships 2025.</p> <p>3) Other factors, such as health, performance trajectory, will be considered, if necessary.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Swiss Ice Skating reserves the right not to fill all slots, the allocation of which depends first of the athletes performances. Swiss Ice Skating reserves the right to decide on exceptional cases not covered in this document.
