6) Selection process	<p>Apart from the skaters automatically nominated (see line item 3), the following criteria apply for the remaining slots/substitute slots provided the athletes are likely to fulfill the goals set forth by Swiss Ice Skating as indicated above:</p> <p>1) Taking into account (<u>in competitions covered under line item 5</u>): the two highest Junior Combined Total Element Score** + - the minimum of a Junior Combined Total Element Score over 60,00 points at the Swiss Junior Championships 2025 for Pairs must have been achieved;</p> <p>2) Other factors, such as health, performance trajectory, will be considered, if necessary.</p>			
	<p>Swiss Ice Skating reserves the right not to fill all slots, the allocation of which depends first of the athletes performances. Swiss Ice Skating reserves the right to decide on exceptional cases not covered in this document. This could include injuries or illness of an athlete, etc. The final selection decision will be made by the Board of Swiss Ice Skating.</p>			
7) Communication by Swiss Ice Skating	Athletes will be informed of their selections not later than December 20, 2024 (incl. for Pairs for whom the ISU Combined Total Element Score must be obtained up to January 26, 2025 in case of selection on December 20, 2024).			

(*) Single skaters who have only been selected for one event in the ISU JGP series 2024-25 will be invited to take part in the ISU Budapest Trophy 2024 / ISU Trophy Metropole Nice Cote d'Azur 2024 in the Junior category to also have the possibility of a minimum of two international competition scores to consider.

(**) Single skaters who take part in the Swiss Senior Championships 2025 instead of the Swiss Junior Championships 2025 will have all their additional technical elements required for Senior deducted from their Combined Total Element Score to be considered as comparatively relevant for the Junior category.
